Student Account Settings

STUDENT ALLERGIES

Nicholas Markets is not a peanut-free facility. However, all menu items are nut-free. Please be very diligent when registering students with food allergies. Under the "Allergies" section of the registration page, please be sure to check off any allergies that Nicholas Markets should be aware of.

Please Note: Depending on which allergen you select, meals/food items containing the selected allergen will be removed from your menu when placing orders. This is on a per student basis - the menu will not change or be affected if one student has an allergy and one student does not.

NO LUNCH? NO PROBLEM!

Nicholas Markets provides students the opportunity to purchase full lunches and/or healthy snacks during their lunch periods. This feature will ensure that your child will receive lunch in situations where (1) you forget to pre-order a lunch for your child or (2) your child forgets his/her packed lunch at home. During registration, by selecting the "My student has permission to purchase lunch at school. You have permission to charge my credit card" option, your child will be granted permission to buy a lunch in an emergency situation by charging to the credit card on file.
